Having a whale of a time!

Contractors P.W. Reynolds approached SureSet in April 2009 to ask us to quote for the paved feature area in the crèche garden at Pokesdown Childrens Centre, part of the Bournemouth YMCA.

The plans called for a series of cartoon like underwater creatures to be recreated in a paddling pool area in the crèche garden, all in vivid primary colours with intricate detailing.

Designed by the graphics team at local architects, Terence O'Rourke, the area was originally intended to be completed using mosaic tiles. However, the flexible design and installation features of SureSet enabled the client to achieve the complexities of the stunning design with the added benefits of providing them with a low maintenance, durable and permeable paving solution that is also covered by a 10 year guarantee.

To achieve the twenty different colour variations that were required for the design, we used mixes from our Spectrum range, which incorporates recycled colour coated glass in virtually any RAL colour, so it was easy to match the colours that were illustrated in the plans.

Laser cut formers were used to complete the outline and detailing of the marine life. SureSet resin bound paving was then hand trowelled into the formers to provide a smooth finish. For the surrounding area, a 3mm Sahara Gold was used to compliment the vivid colours in the mural and to give the appearance of sand surrounding the water.

Joni Carpenter, Sales Advisor for SureSet, worked on the project from start to finish and commented "The finished result looks brilliant. The operations and installation team worked really hard to provide our client with an outstanding finish".

Newtons Cove Footbridge, Weymouth

Dorset County Council enlisted the expertise of SureSet to complete the resin bound paving works on the new footbridge at Newtons Cove in Weymouth. The stainless steel footbridge forms part of the south west coastal path which extends along the coastline from Poole Harbour to Clevedon in North Somerset, replaces the recently demolished concrete bridge that was originally in situ.

The designs for the new bridge called for a neutral colour pallet including greys, buffs and sand colours so aggregates from the natural gravel and crushed rock range were used to complete the stylish design, created by artist Chris Tipping. The patterns incorporated in the resin bound paving on the footbridge were designed to emulate the cartographic symbols originally found on old ordnance survey maps, from which the artist found his inspiration.

SureSet permeable resin bound paving is used in a wide variety of applications, adding life, colour and texture to pathways and public spaces. It can be used to replicate intricate and complex designs with great precision and provides clients with a design flexibility that no other paving can match. SureSet permeable paving is durable and low maintenance, it can also be laid directly onto most waterproofing membranes, which is great for a project such as this bridge deck.
